Peace in the Lord!

Your letter has been widely received in the church community recently. First, thank you for your concern for church affairs. However, we must solemnly state: "Chinese Coordination Centre of World Evangelism of Canada (CCCWE Canada)" is a platform dedicated to connecting, inspiring, and equipping Chinese churches to fulfill their global mission. We are not a denominational organization, nor do we manage or oversee any church. Therefore, we have no authority to intervene in the internal disputes of individual churches, nor are we suited to handle disputes and complaints between pastors and congregants.

The content of your letter involves both personal reputation and the church's prestige, a matter of grave importance. We urge you not to rashly disseminate serious accusations via email without proper verification, legal procedures, or appropriate church communication mechanisms. This could harm the reputations of those involved and potentially lead to legal liability for defamation. Such actions not only violate the biblical teachings of "love your neighbor as yourself" and "care for one another," but also easily cause unnecessary division and harm within the Chinese Christian community.

Since the church you mentioned is the Toronto Chinese Bible Church, we suggest that you consider contacting the church or its affiliated association directly through normal channels to seek an appropriate response and handling.

We have read the apology letter you wrote to Pastor Gong. We pray that the Lord Jesus will grant you a heart of wisdom. May you find strength and guidance in the Lord, continue to live for Him in a way that glorifies God and benefits others, and devote more energy and attention to evangelism.
